The Goat Classes are held under the Rules, Regulations and Recognition of the British Goat Society. All exhibits must be registered with the BGS as in the ownership and in the name of the exhibitor, the registered name and number being quoted on the entry form. (Also the kidding date for goats in milk). All goats in milk must have kidded or aborted a minimum of 30 days previous to the date of the Show.

No pregnant goat may be admitted to the Showground. In the event of any unforeseen kidding or abortion, the goat must be immediately isolated from other goats. Full details of the goat, exhibitor and action taken must be reported in writing by the Chief Steward, to the BGS Secretary, immediately after the Show.

All goats in milk are to be on the Showground by 5.15 pm on Friday 28 June 2019, and be stripped dry at 6.00 pm under the supervision of approved stewards whether such goats are competing in the milking competition or not. Full Udder Inspection to take place at 6.30 am on 29 June, followed by the milking competition, with the Inspection classes starting at 9.30 am.

Any kid exhibited must be not less than two calendar months old on the day of the Show. Youngstock to be on the Showground by 9.00 am on Saturday 29 June 2019.

**CAE REGULATIONS**

**BGS Monitored Herds.**

A current certificate must be included with entries.

**Privately Tested Herds**

Proof of a clear test within twelve months prior to the date of the Show MUST be included with entries. Veterinary certificates and test results must be for the whole herd and kids must be out of negative tested dams, identified on the certificate.

**ENTRY FEES**

£3.00 per pen. Pens to hold 1 adult; 1 goatling or buckling or up to 3 kids.

Straw available at a cost of £3.00 per bale. Straw to be ordered and paid for on the entry form.

**MILKER****Female Goat that has borne a kid, in milk**

- Class 1** British Guernsey Female Goat that has borne a kid, in milk, first kidder.
- Class 2** British Guernsey Female Goat that has borne a kid, in milk, second and subsequent kidders up to 6 years.
- Class 3** British Guernsey Female Goat that has borne a kid, in milk, second and subsequent kidders 6 years and over.
- Class 4** Any other variety Female Goat in milk with a Golden Guernsey or British Guernsey parent.

**GOATLING****Female Goat over one year but not exceeding 2 years, that has not borne a kid**

- Class 5** British Guernsey Goatling.
- Class 6** Any other variety goatling with a Golden Guernsey or British Guernsey parent.

**KID****Female Goat over 2 months but not exceeding one year that has not borne a kid**

- Class 7** British Guernsey Female Kid.
- Class 8** Any other variety female kid with a Golden Guernsey or British Guernsey parent.

**MALE KID****Male Goat over 2 months but not exceeding one year**

- Class 9** British Guernsey Male Kid.
- Class 10** Any other variety male kid with a Golden Guernsey or British Guernsey parent.

**BUCKLING****Male Goat over one year but not exceeding 2 years**

- Class 11** British Guernsey Buckling.
- Class 12** Any other variety buckling with a Golden Guernsey or British Guernsey parent.

**ADULT MALE****Male Goat over 2 years**

- Class 13** British Guernsey Male Goat.
- Class 14** Any other variety male goat with a Golden Guernsey or British Guernsey parent.
- Class 15** Sire and Progeny. The sire and progeny to have been entered in their appropriate classes.
- Class 16** Dam and Daughter in same ownership. The dam and daughter to have been entered in their appropriate classes.
- Class 17** Milking Competition British Guernsey first kidders.
- Class 18** Milking Competition British Guernsey second and subsequent kidders.
- Class 19** Milking Competition any other variety female goat with a Golden Guernsey or British Guernsey parent.
