The Goat Classes are held under the Rules, Regulations and Recognition of the British Goat Society. All exhibits must be registered with the BGS as in the ownership and in the name of the exhibitor, the registered name and number being quoted on the entry form. (Also the kidding date for goats in milk). All goats in milk must have kidded or aborted a minimum of 30 days previous to the date of the Show.

No pregnant goat may be admitted to the Showground. In the event of any unforeseen kidding or abortion, the goat must be immediately isolated from other goats. Full details of the goat, exhibitor and action taken must be reported in writing by the Chief Steward, to the BGS Secretary, immediately after the Show.

All goats in milk are to be on the Showground by 5.15 pm on Friday 28th June 2019, and be stripped dry at 6.00 pm under the supervision of approved stewards whether such goats are competing in the milking competition or not. Full Udder Inspection to take place at 6.30 am on 29th June, followed by the milking competition, with the Inspection classes starting at 9.30 am.

Any kid exhibited must be not less than two calendar months old on the day of the Show. Youngstock to be on the Showground by 9.00 am on Saturday 29th June 2019.

**CAE REGULATIONS**

**BGS Monitored Herds.**

A current certificate must be included with entries.

**Privately Tested Herds**

Proof of a clear test within twelve months prior to the date of the Show MUST be included with entries. Veterinary certificates and test results must be for the whole herd and kids must be out of negative tested dams, identified on the certificate.

**ENTRY FEES**

£3.00 per pen. Pens to hold 1 adult; 1 goatling or buckling or up to 3 kids. Straw available at a cost of £3.00 per bale. Straw to be ordered and paid for on the entry form.

## **MILKER**

### **Female Goat that has borne a kid, in milk**

- Class 1** Golden Guernsey Female Goat that has borne a kid, in milk, first kidder.
- Class 2** Golden Guernsey Female Goat that has borne a kid, in milk, second and subsequent kidders up to 6 years.
- Class 3** Golden Guernsey Female Goat that has borne a kid, in milk, second and subsequent kidders 6 years and over.

## **GOATLING**

### **Female Goat over one year but not exceeding 2 years, that has not borne a kid**

- Class 4** Golden Guernsey Goatling.

## **KID**

### **Female Goat over 2 months but not exceeding one year that has not borne a kid**

- Class 5** Golden Guernsey Female Kid.

## **MALE KID**

### **Male Goat over 2 months but not exceeding one year**

- Class 6** Golden Guernsey Male Kid.

## **BUCKLING**

### **Male Goat over one year but not exceeding 2 years**

- Class 7** Golden Guernsey Buckling.

## **ADULT MALE**

### **Male Goat over 2 years**

- Class 8** Golden Guernsey Male Goat.
- Class 9** Sire and Progeny. The sire and progeny to have been entered in their appropriate classes.
- Class 10** Dam and Daughter in same ownership. The dam and daughter to have been entered in their appropriate classes.
- Class 11** Milking Competition Golden Guernsey first kidders.
- Class 12** Milking Competition Golden Guernsey second and subsequent kidders.
